Approval of Minutes of the November 19, 2019 Board of Estimates Meeting

The minutes of the November 19, 2019 Board of Estimates Meeting were approved by general consent.

Item No. 12-10-19-01

Ms. Creighton presented Solicitation No. 20-134; Partial Roof Replacement Emmorton Recreation Center; Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Ms. Barkley Creighton from the Department of Public Works, Capital Projects, is requesting approval for the removal and replacement of two (2) low slope roof areas and two mansard shingle roof areas along with associated trim, gutter, and downspouts.

The Department of Public Works, Capital Projects, recommends award in the amount of \$106,550.00 per year to Ron Ruff Roofing, Inc. of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-02

Mr. Kuba presented Solicitation No. 20-183; Cisco Catalyst 9500 Switches; Piggyback- State of Maryland #060B2490022.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Nick Kuba from the Department of Information and Communication Technology stated that this proposal is for the purchase of two (2) Cisco Catalyst 9500 Switches to be installed at the Northern Precinct and will serve as an HMAN distribution site to provide connectivity for multiple sites.

The Department of Information and Communication Technology recommends award in the amount of \$52,709.04 to IP DataSystems, Inc. in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-03

Ms. Buckley presented Solicitation No. 20-105; Emmord Stream Restoration; Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Ms. Christine Buckley from the Department of Public Works, Stormwater Management, is requesting approval for the installation of a stormwater treatment bar to improve water quality and the restoration of approximately 975 linear feet of stream channel of an unnamed tributary of Emmord Branch. The project is located on the Magnolia Middle School property in Joppa, MD.

This project will be constructed as part of the County's MS4 permit requirement to improve stream health by reducing nutrients and sediments to local streams and the Chesapeake Bay.

The Department of Public Works, Stormwater Management, recommends award in the amount of \$494,239.94 to Stormwater Maintenance, LLC of Hunt Valley, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-04

Mr. Patrick presented Solicitation No. 20-173; Compact Track Loader; Request for Quote.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Warren Patrick from the Department of Procurement, Fleet Management, is requesting approval for the purchase of one (1) 2019 John Deere 333G Compact Track Loader.

The Department of Procurement, Fleet Management, recommends award in the amount of \$113,113.96 to Atlantic Tractor, LLC of Whiteford, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-05

Mr. Blazinsky presented Solicitation No. 20-135; Engineering and Construction of Bus Shelters; Piggyback-Sourcewell Contract #071415-GGI.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

On behalf of the Office of Economic Development, Mr. Gary Blazinsky from Harford Transit stated that this proposal is for the design, engineering, and construction of Bus Shelters in various locations throughout Harford County.

The Office of Economic Development, Harford Transit, recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$539,237.00 to Centennial Contractors Enterprises, Inc. of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-06

Mr. Blazinsky presented Solicitation No. 20-146; Six (6) Small Cutaway Buses for Harford Transit LINK; Piggyback-State of Georgia Contract #99999-001-SPD0000138-002.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

On behalf of the Office of Economic Development, Mr. Gary Blazinsky from Harford Transit stated that this proposal is for the purchase of six (6) Small Cutaway replacement and expansion buses for the Harford Transit LINK public transit fleet. Vehicles within the current fleet have exceeded useful life and have been granted funding and concurrence by our partners at MTA to be replaced.

The Office of Economic Development, Harford Transit, recommends award in the amount of \$540,514.86 to Alliance Bus Group, Inc. of College Park, GA in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 12-10-19-07

Mr. Blazinsky presented Solicitation No. 20-147; Medium Duty Harford Transit LINK Buses; Piggyback- State of Maryland Contract #MOL-18-005-EQ.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

On behalf of the Office of Economic Development, Mr. Gary Blazinsky from Harford Transit stated that this proposal is for the purchase of five (5) Medium Duty Cutaway replacement and expansion buses for the Harford Transit LINK public transit fleet. The vehicles that these buses will be replacing have already been retired from Harford Transit LINK service and disposed of. The funding and concurrence has been granted by our partners at MTA.

The Office of Economic Development, Harford Transit, recommends award in the amount of \$1,950,785.00 to American Truck & Bus, Inc. of Annapolis, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.
