County Executive Glassman Orders Harford County Flag Lowered for Former Maryland Delegate Dr. Rose Mary Hatem Bonsack

BEL AIR, Md., (Oct. 1, 2020) - County Executive Barry Glassman has ordered the Harford County flag lowered to half-staff, effective immediately, in honor of former Maryland delegate Dr. Rose Mary Hatem Bonsack, who died on September 27, 2020. Dr. Bonsack served in the House of Delegates from 1991 to 1999, including three years as chair of the Harford delegation.

“In addition to her successful career, Rose Mary will be remembered for her kindness and devotion to her family and her community,” County Executive Glassman said. “I am proud that she was also a fellow graduate of Washington College and one of my mentors. Harford County will keep her and her loved ones in our prayers.”

The Harford County flag will remain at half-staff through sunset on Sunday, October 4, 2020.
