Harford County Cultural Arts Board to Hold Grant Training Workshop

BEL AIR, Md., (Jan. 28, 2015) - The Harford County Cultural Arts Board (HCCAB) will hold a grant training workshop on Wednesday, February 25, at the University Center (formerly known as the HEAT Center) located at 1201 Technology Drive in Aberdeen.

The workshop is open to any non-profit organization that is interested in learning about grant opportunities for funding the arts for the fiscal year 2016. The training session will give an overview of the Community Art Development Grants available through the Harford County Cultural Arts Board, and review how to file an e-grant through the HCCAB website www.CulturalArtsBoard.org.
