May 24, 2018 Minutes**

- I. Call meeting to order 0636
  - a. CAB Members in Attendance: Jay DuBree, Lawrson Sayre, Linda Stine Flint, Diane Harmon
  - b. 15 people in attendance
- II. Sheriff's update (Captain Peter Georgiades)
  - a. 36 overdoses; 44 use of narcan by law enforcement; 12 repeat use – 9 of the same individuals
  - b. Narcan numbers from family members/people/hospital not reported in these numbers. Narcan is so accessible so Narcan use report not accurate
  - c. Top 3 calls alarm 35 ; suspicious person 32; animal 16
  - d. Calls for service 661
  - e. Crime: Burglary 3; Theft 2
  - f. Lock your car!!
  - g. Not signing the kids over to the parent anymore. Printing juveniles, serious misdemeanors, gang affiliation, excessive record -- dept of juvenile services is the one who decides what is charged.
  - h. Mention of the marijuana problem... CPT explained legislature is what decided
  - i. Pat Vincenti did ridealong 2 different shifts
- III. Presentation: Maryland State Delegate, Andrew Cassilly
  - 136 – Royal Farms store – went to the state with cab ideas. The right turn only lane, Signs are up, Turn arrow at 136 to go north. Lower the speed on rt 155 in front of the elementary school -- State said no to posting the speed limit. Retaining wall at the school by cafeteria was falling over. It was fixed
  - The side road off 155 to 136... change the direction to make it one way to 136; Need left turn lane from 22 to 155 – traffic backed up
  - 543/22 - state is calling for 2 left turn lanes on 22 coming towards 543
  - Pat has meeting with developers of the eva mar property . right now nothing more than than a traffic light. Will look at what they are obligated to do. Stepney rd and rt 22 same issue, No sidewalks , Crossing the street at the high school
  - McDonalds at the 22/college -- worthwhile to have a crossing; Why No bike lanes
  - Allows the county the flexibility to decide ; In the morning the traffic backs up
