AGREEMENT

The undersigned agrees to the terms of the attached standard plan for forest harvest operations and to grant inspectors the right of entry to the site to monitor compliance. Each of the undersigned is aware of the property owner's responsibility in preventing accelerated erosion and sedimentation during and subsequent to forest harvest operations as mandated by the rules and regulations adopted by the State of Maryland and the local ordinances and rules and regulations of Harford County, Maryland. The undersigned agrees to require that all operators conducting forest harvest operations of the above named property shall adhere to the requirements of the standard plan and any amendments to the plan. Removal of stumps in harvest operations is not permitted, except as necessary for landing areas or haul roads under the terms of this permit. This permit expires one year from the date signed by the Department of Public Works.
