# WATER TOWERS AT WORK FOR YOU

# TOGETHER WE CAN PROTECT THE SOURCE

## Harford County's 12 water towers provide:

- Pressure to move water through the system; each foot of height provides 0.43 pounds per square inch (PSI)
- Emergency storage for fire protection
- Reservoirs to stabilize the supply throughout the day

As part of our regular maintenance to extend equipment life, we will repair, refurbish, and paint towers this year in Joppa and Bel Air North.



## What can you do?

- Properly use and dispose of harmful materials, including chemicals, unused household cleansers, paint & oils. Harford County hosts household hazardous waste days every year for easy disposal.
- Never flush unused medicines. Harford County has prescription drug take back events and permanent drop-off boxes.
- Don't overuse pesticides or fertilizers; they could run off to nearby surface water or contaminate ground water.
- Conserve and avoid water waste:
  - Take shorter showers
  - Do not run water unnecessarily
  - Water your plants early in the morning
  - Fix leaks

## MONEY-SAVING TIP:

A leaky toilet could cost you \$50 per month in unnecessary water usage. To check for leaks:

- Listen for running water after the tank fills, or
- Add a few drops of food coloring to the tank. Don't flush. If color shows in the bowl after an hour, you have a leak.

Most repairs only require the simple and inexpensive replacement of a worn flapper.
