Why participate in the 2020 Census:

- ▶ Access important local, regional and state programs that receive federal dollars determined by the census count such as:
 - SNAP
 - National School Lunch Program
 - Special Supplemental Nutritional Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC)
 - Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers Program
 - Medicaid
 - Head Start
 - Child Care and Development Fund
 - Title 1 education grants
- ▶ Fair representation in government ensures your needs are understood
- ▶ Help determine the number of stores, hospitals, non-profit organizations, new businesses and jobs in your community

The U.S. census is a count of where everyone lives and sleeps most of the time. Hispanic children are the most undercounted*. ALL ages can participate. One census form is completed per household.
