

Wooden Bead Garland



This wooden bead garland is an easy craft that anyone can do! You can create a garland as a personal décor item or as a gift, such as a Christmas gift.

Supplies Needed:

Here are the supplies you will need:

- Varying sizes of natural wooden beads
- A spool of twine
- Scotch tape
- Sharp scissors
- Tape measure

You can use colored beads in green and red if you like.



Step 1:

Cut a piece of twine approximately 60" long. You will be trimming that length later.

Use tape to wrap one end of the twine to make the threading easier. Tie a loose knot on the other end of the twine.



Step 2:

Begin threading your beads, using a pattern or all the same size, however you like.



Step 3:

When the desired length is reached, create tassels. Use the twine to wrap around an object. I used my drink bottle, wrapping around 8 times. Slide the twine off.



Step 4:

Untie the loose knot on the end of the twine strand and tie the loop of twine to the end of the strand. Cut a length of twine and tie the loop tightly.



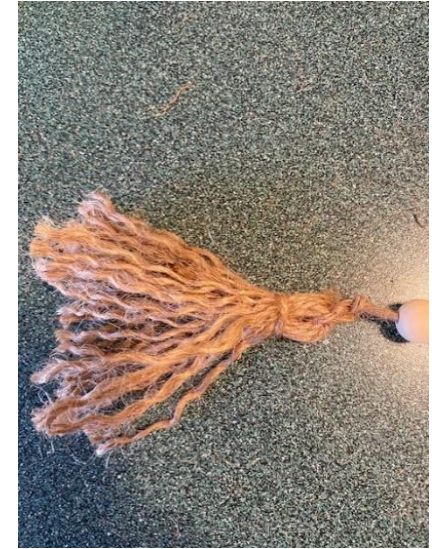
Step 5:

Cut the loop to create the tassel. Trim the ends.



Step 6:

And your first tassel is finished! You can leave it as is or fray the ends. Cut the tape off of the other end, make sure the beads or strung fairly snug, and add the same tassel on the opposite end.



Here's your finished project! It looks pretty in many décor settings!
