



## **Reopening Plan- Harford County Parks & Recreation 2021**

In each phase of this plan, all of the governor's executive orders must be met, including group size, mask wearing and social distancing requirements. These phases are for Harford County Parks & Recreation facilities only. They do not apply to other sites, such as Harford County Board of Education properties.

### **Phase 1 – Monday, February 1**

- Outdoor organized activities will be allowed on county facilities for independent recreation council programs and for Harford County Parks & Recreation programs.
- All activities at Cedar Lane can resume.
- The McFaul Skate Park will open every day from 10 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

### **Phase 2 – Monday, March 1**

- Outdoor organized activities can resume for non-recreation council programs. Permits can be received by contacting the local Harford County Parks & Recreation office.
- Rentals of outdoor pavilions will be allowed.

### **Phase 3 – Monday, March 1**

- Indoor activities for recreation councils and Harford County Parks & Recreation programs can resume. If programs have previously submitted a COVID-19 plan to Parks & Recreation, they should update it and submit it through the same procedures previously established. All programs must submit a plan before they will be approved for the use of indoor facilities. Plan submittal can begin Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Emmorton Tennis members can resume use of the facility.
- Swan Harbor Farm events can resume.
- McFaul Skate Park resumes normal operating hours
- Building partners (those who have MOU's with Harford County Parks & Recreation) may resume operations.
- Senior centers closed by the governor's executive order will remain closed until the order is lifted.

### **Phase 4 – As determined by the county executive in consultation with the Harford County Health Department:**

All COVID-related restrictions are lifted and activities return to regular operations.
