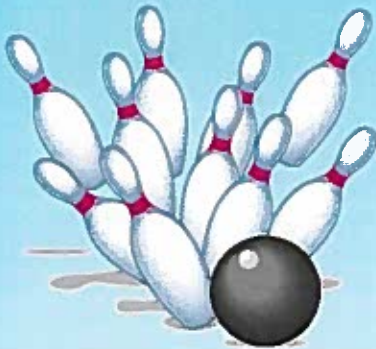
Aloha Dance

Bowling

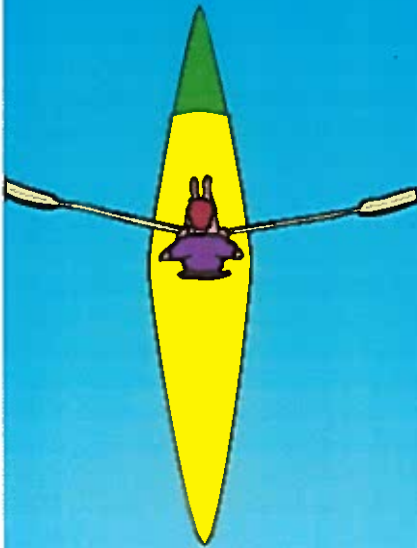

be accompanied by a parent. Please contact Matt Frosolone at 410-638-3988 with questions. The registration form is included for your convenience.





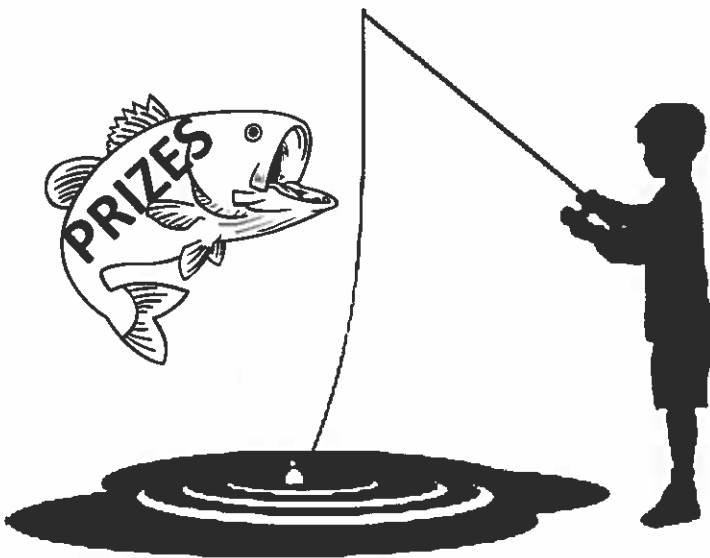
