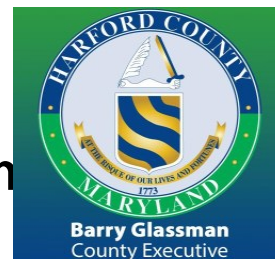

1. The Fishing Rodeo is open to ages 15 and under. All children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to attend and fish with the children however all fish must be reeled in by the children.
2. The pond will be stocked with rainbow trout prior to the event. The pond also has largemouth bass, bluegill, catfish, crappie and golden shiners.
3. This is a Catch and Release event except for Rainbow trout. Trophies will be awarded to the three heaviest fish caught at the end of the program. The fish will be weighed in at the registration table.
4. Door prizes will be presented to lucky winners.
5. Participants are encouraged to bring their own fishing tackle. A limited number of rods and reels will be available for use that day.
6. Bait will be provided. Power bait and night crawlers.
7. No fishing license required for this event.
