- Edgewood Senior Activity Center, located on Gateway Drive in Edgewood
- Highland Senior Activity Center, located on Highland Road in Highland
- Havre de Grace Activities Center, located on Lewis Lane in Havre de Grace
- McFaul Activities Center, located on MacPhail Road in Bel Air

The centers will be open effective immediately and will stay open through 4:00 PM today, August 11, and will be open tomorrow, Wednesday, August 12 from 8:30 AM until 4 PM.
