### **Harford County to Begin Biannual Flushing of Fire Hydrants**

The Harford County Department of Public Works, Division of Water and Sewer will begin its biannual flushing of fire hydrants. The process will commence on Monday, September 7, 2009 and should be completed by early December of this year.

There are approximately 4,000 fire hydrants that will be flushed by the county during his period. Flushing will be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

"The flushing of fire hydrants may result in a temporary discoloration of water, changes in water pressure and temporary interruption of water service during the flushing process," stated Water and Sewer facilities chief Edward Kimmel. "We ask for the cooperation and understanding of our customers and apologize for any inconveniences created by the flushing operation," Kimmel remarked.
