Rick Russell gave the Jarrettsville - Norrisville Planning Council report in Bill's absence.

A representative from the Sheriff's Office - Community Policing Unit - reviewed current crime statistics in the Jarrettsville - Norrisville area. There have been a few burglaries (5) in the month of February. Residents are encouraged to lock doors on houses, cars and barns. A request was made to find out how close to a property line target shooting is allowed in Harford County.

Councilman Chad Shrodes thanked David Jones for his excellent work on the MTBE and Gasoline Storage Task Force. Chad reminded us to attend the Community Impact meeting on Tuesday, April 28, 2009, at 6:30 p.m. at the Norrisville Library to review the plans for Norrisville Park and additional parking project. There will also be a Comprehensive Zoning meeting on April 1, 2009, at North Harford High School. Chad reported that "rumble" strips are to be placed at the intersection of Rts. 439 and 23. Speed enforcement on Jarrettsville Pike continues to be a concern.
