



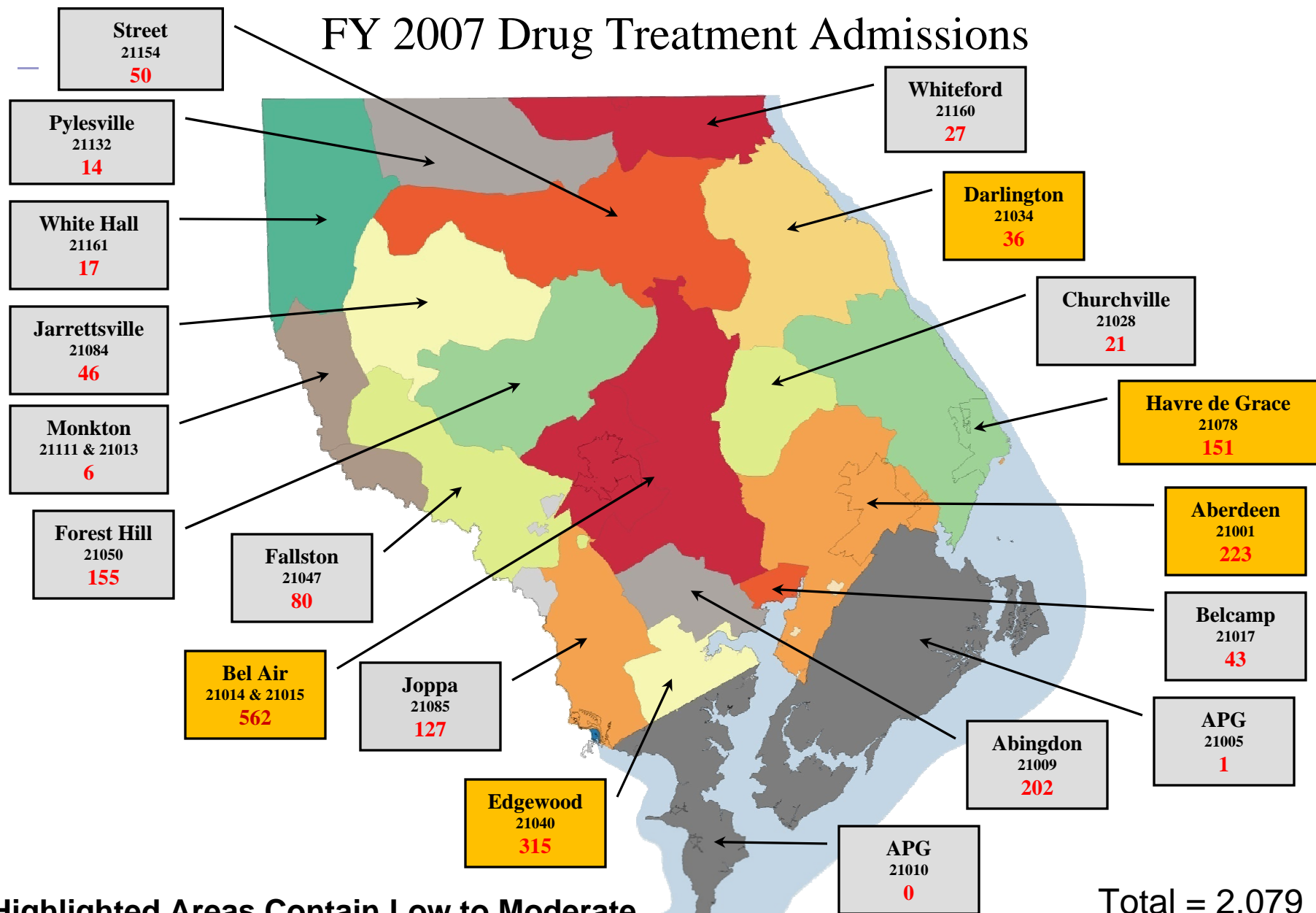
Crime Drugs and Arrests



Summary - Drugs and Arrests

- In FY 2007, 2,075 Harford County residents were admitted for drug treatment in Maryland facilities. The Harford County zip codes with the highest number of residents admitted for drug treatment in Maryland were the two Bel Air zip codes combined (562), Edgewood (315), Aberdeen (223), and Abingdon (202).
- The number of Harford County juveniles who were arrested dropped from 1,775 in 2007 to 1,666 in 2008. In both years, the zip codes with the highest percentages of juvenile arrest were Edgewood, Aberdeen, Bel Air 21014, Abingdon, Bel Air 21015, Havre de Grace, and Joppa.

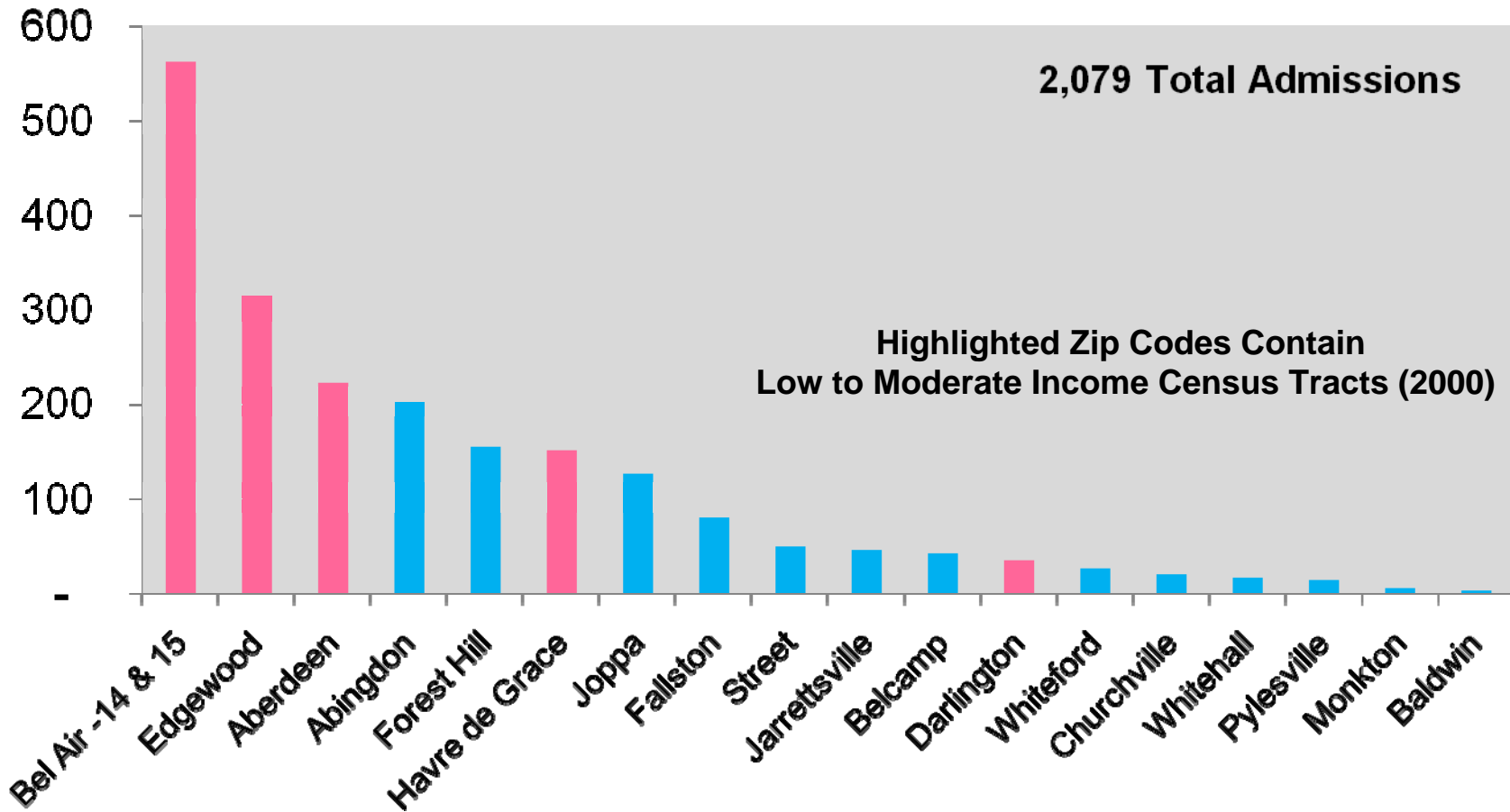
FY 2007 Drug Treatment Admissions



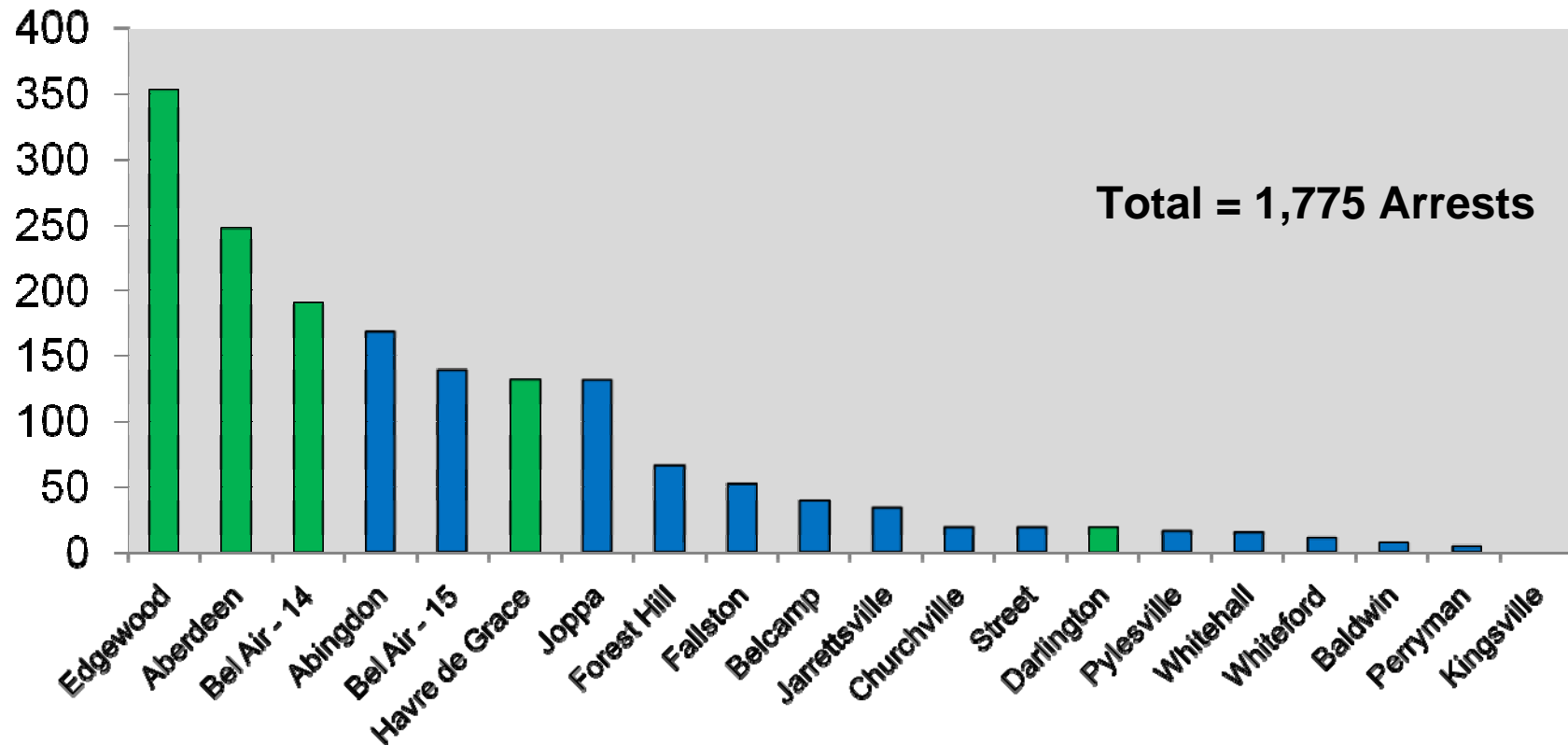

2007 Juvenile Crime Statistics

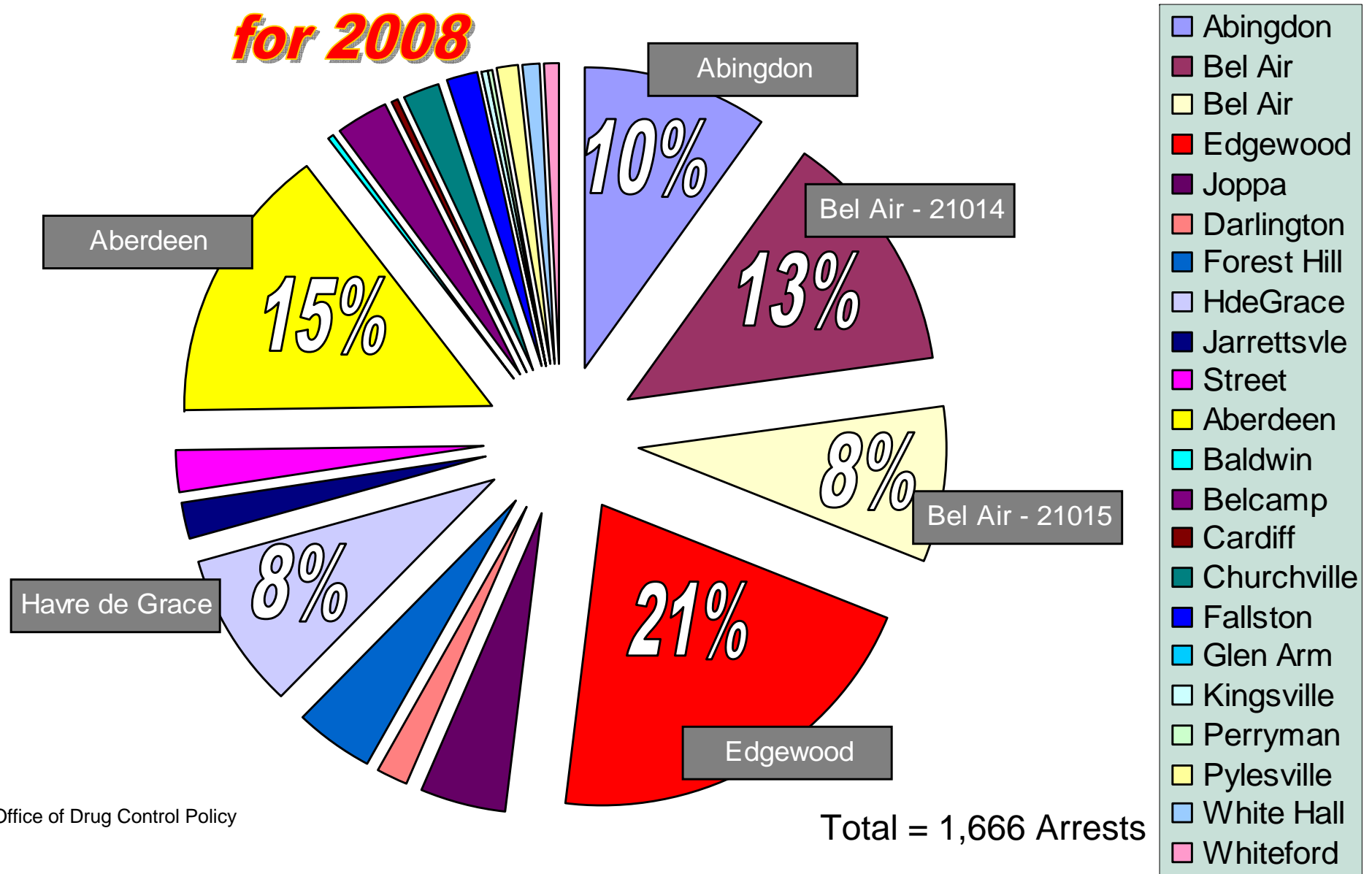


Highlighted zip codes contain low to moderate income census tracts from the 2000 U.S. Census
