



PARENTAL CONTROL APPS

BARK



- Proactively monitors text messages, YouTube, emails, and 24 different social networks for potential safety concerns.
- Works on iOS, Android, and Amazon mobile devices

SAFERKID TEXT MONITORING APP



- Allows parents access to a child's text message and web browsing history; can block potentially dangerous or inappropriate content, and limit screen time.
- Works on iPad and iPhone devices

SCREEN TIME



- Allows parents to manage screen time.
- Works on Android and iOS devices

CIRCLE



- Manages connected devices - anywhere they are. Helps parents and children locate family members through their devices.
- Works on Android and iOS devices

ESET PARENTAL CONTROL



- Monitors content and controls screen-time; includes a child locator that lets parents receive alerts when a child leaves a permitted zone.
- Works on Android devices

KASPERSKY SAFE KIDS



- Monitors content and controls screen-time; includes a GPS tracker to monitor kids' locations.
- Works on Windows, Mac, iPhone/iPad, and Android devices

NET NANNY



- Monitors content and controls screen-time, location tracker provides current location, access to location history, and frequented locations of your child's device.
- Works on Windows, Android, iOS, and Kindle devices

NORTON FAMILY PREMIER



- Helps parents guide and monitor kids on the web; includes a locator that can provide the current device location and a thirty-day history of locations.
- Works on some Windows, some Android, and some iOS devices

OUR PACT PARENTAL CONTROL APP



- Allows parents to control content and screen-time; has a locator feature that sends an alert when children arrive and depart designated areas such as school, home, etc.
- Works on Android devices

QUSTODIO



- Monitors content and controls screen-time; provides location tracking for devices and a panic alert feature that allows kids to send a message to their parents when they are in danger.
- Works on Windows, Mac OS X, Android, iOS, and Kindle devices
- Available in other languages
