Mr. Barry Glassman notified the attendees that Harford County Government was following protocol under the Open Meetings Act.

Approval of Minutes of the December 7, 2021 Board of Estimates Meeting

The minutes of the December 7, 2021 Board of Estimates Meeting were approved by general consent.

Item No. 01-11-22-01

Mr. Patashnick presented Solicitation No. 22-201; Professional Standards Software; Sole Source.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Patashnick from the Office of the State's Attorney for Harford County stated that this proposal is for the purchase of IAPro and Blue Team Software to record, document, and maintain police misconduct records. The software will allow the State's Attorney and Police to efficiently share information and build a common front of transparency.

The Office of the State's Attorney for Harford County recommends award in the amount of \$100,000.00 to CI Technologies, Inc. of St. Augustine, FL in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-02

Mr. Patrick presented Solicitation No. 22-198; Whirlwind Street Sweeper; Piggyback- Sourcewell Contract # 093021-ELG.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Warren Patrick from the Department of Procurement, Fleet Management, on behalf of the Department of Public Works, stated that this proposal is for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Elgin Whirlwind Street Sweeper for the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways.

The Department of Procurement, Fleet Management, recommends award in the amount of \$294,146.00 to Maryland Industrial Trucks, Inc. of Linthicum, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-03

Mr. Burke presented Solicitation No. 22-148; Ultraviolet Cured in Place Pipe (UV CIPP); Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Charlie Burke from the Department of Public Works is requesting approval to provide ultraviolet cured in place pipe lining (UV CIPP). The underground pipe infrastructure drains water throughout the County. UV CIPP lining will be provided for various drainage infrastructure installations and repair solutions at various locations throughout the County. The UV CIPP lining process creates a stronger and longer lasting liner which reduces the time needed to make repairs, eliminating the requirement to dig out and replace drainpipes which has been done in the past.

The Department of Public Works recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$600,000.00 per year to Pleasants Construction, Inc. of Clarksburg, MD accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-04

Mr. Schoenberger presented Solicitation No. 22-041; Intergovernmental Agreement for Solid Waste Management Services; Change Order # 2.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Jeffrey Schoenberger from the Department of Public Works stated that this proposal is to replace the failing retaining wall at the Tollgate Residential Yard Trim Acceptance Facility and to replace an employee trailer at the Harford Mulch and Compost Facility due to being deteriorated.

The Department of Public Works requests approval for Change Order # 2 in the amount not to exceed \$361,890.00, increasing the contract not to exceed total to \$7,738,505.00 to MES- Maryland Environmental Service of Millersville, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-05

Ms. Hoover presented Solicitation No. 22-101; Rock Glenn Park; Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Ms. Angela Hoover from the Department of Parks and Recreation is requesting approval for the construction of fields, a trail, basketball/pickleball court, and parking at Rock Glenn Park, which will be a new park near the City of Aberdeen.

The Department of Parks and Recreation recommends award in the amount of \$1,097,576.00 to Ivy Hill Nursery Company, Inc. of Bel Air, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-06

Mr. Peplinski presented Solicitation No. 22-191; KH-3020 1-95 NB at Abingdon Road Water Main Relocation; Negotiated Procurement.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. David Peplinski from the Department of Public Works is requesting approval to relocate water mains under 1-95 and along Abingdon Road to accommodate the proposed 1-95 Northbound Express Toll lanes.

The Department of Public Works recommends award in the amount of \$330,250.00 to Maryland Transportation Authority of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-07

Mr. Magness presented Solicitation No. 21-253 on behalf of Dave Goodwin; Synthetic Turf Fields Maintenance; Piggyback- Sourcewell Contract # 060518-AST.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Paul Magness from the Department of Parks and Recreation stated that this proposal is for the cleaning, repair, and maintenance of the synthetic turf fields throughout Harford County. This contract is to augment those services and provide repair beyond the capabilities provided by the Harford County crews that provide general maintenance.

The Department of Parks and Recreation recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 per year to AstroTurf Corporation of Dalton, GA in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-08

Mr. Magness presented Solicitation No. 22-147 on behalf of Dave Goodwin; Tennis Courts, Multi Use Courts, Tracks; Piggyback- Baltimore County Contract # B-1607.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Paul Magness from the Department of Parks and Recreation stated that this proposal is for the renovation to courts and tracks throughout Harford County.

The Department of Parks and Recreation recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$600,000.00 per year to ATC Corporation of Baltimore, MD and The American Asphalt Paving Company, LLC of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-09

Mr. Gable presented Solicitation No. 22-118; Water & Sewer Pumps and Equipment; Sole Source.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Phil Gable from the Department of Public Works stated that this proposal is for the repair and/ or purchase of pumps, mixers, equipment, and service.

The Department of Public Works recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$120,000.00 per year to Geiger Pump and Equipment Company of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-10

Mr. Gable presented Solicitation No. 22-177; Wastewater Equipment, Parts, and Factory Service; Sole Source.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Phil Gable from the Department of Public Works stated that this proposal is for wastewater equipment, parts, and factory service for water and sewer operations.

The Department of Public Works recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$225,000.00 per year to Freemire & Associates, Inc. of Harmans, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-11-22-11

Mr. Gable presented Solicitation No. 22-077; Boiler Pressure Vessel Maintenance; Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Phil Gable from the Department of Public Works is requesting approval for boiler maintenance and repair services.

The Department of Public Works recommends award in the amount not to exceed \$85,000.00 per year to Flotron Contracting, Inc. of Hunt Valley, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.
