## Report

Five applications have been received for the FY 2021 CJCC community contributions. The application period closes on August 31, 2020

Mr. Erik Robey answered questions about the status of Covid-19 testing and disinfecting measures at the Harford County Detention Center in response to an inquiry from Ms. Kelly Casper of the Harford County Public Defender’s Office. Delegate McComas asked about the possibility of video conferencing with clients so attorneys do not have to enter the detention center.

Delegate McComas spoke about the upcoming legislative session and asked for the views and insights of the members to take to the House Police Accountability Work Group. She said that some of the ideas being considered for next year’s legislative session include decreased police funding, civilian review boards, and removing some of the protections included in the Law Enforcement Officer’s Bill of Rights (LEOBR).
