Old Business:

- The Board discussed the House Bill 1052, Public Safety - Natural Gas and Liquefied Propane Piping Systems - Construction Requirements. The House bill became effective October 1, 2022. The bill includes prohibitions for the installation of non-arc-resistant corrugated stainless-steel tubing (CSST). The Board discussed clarification around the Bill. Mr. Badders discussed proper electrical grounding.
- Mr. Schott discussed OSHA and Harford County continuing to enforce trench safety to contractors in the field.

- Mr. Schott proposed discussing Harford County code updates on water service grounding and grease traps at a future meeting.
