County Executive Glassman Orders Harford County Flag Lowered, Moment of Silence February 10 for Fallen Deputies Dailey and Logsdon

BEL AIR, Md., (Feb. 6, 2019) - County Executive Barry Glassman has ordered the Harford County flag lowered and plans a countywide moment of silence on Sunday, February 10 for two sheriff's deputies who gave their lives in the line of duty three years ago.

In honor of fallen heroes Senior Deputy Patrick Dailey and Deputy First Class Mark Logsdon, the county executive has requested that local volunteer fire companies sound their sirens with three short blasts at noon on Sunday for citizens to observe a private moment of silence. He has also ordered the Harford County flag to fly at half-staff from sunrise February 8 through sunset February 11.

The county administration building in Bel Air will be lit in blue for one week in support of all law enforcement.
