Harford to Require Masks for Visitors to County Government Buildings Effective Jan. 4

BEL AIR, Md., (Jan. 3, 2022) - Consistent with Gov. Hogan's actions earlier today, Harford County will require masks for visitors in county buildings and for county government employees who interact with the public, effective at 9 a.m. Tuesday, January 4, 2022, until further notice. The action is to help maintain staffing levels and keep county government open and serving customers through the surge in COVID-19 cases.

Harford County businesses continue to have the option of requiring masks in their facilities. Citizens are encouraged to manage their risk by following best practices, which include wearing masks and social distancing in crowded indoor settings. Citizens are also encouraged to get the vaccine and the booster if they are eligible as one of the best ways to avoid serious illness and hospitalization.
