Work may not begin until the permit is approved. Call the Department of Public Works-Inspections at 410-638-3217 ext. 2434 prior to the start of harvest operations. The Standard Erosion & Sediment Control Plan must be available on-site during harvest operations.

AGREEMENT

The undersigned agrees to the terms of the attached Standard Erosion and Sediment Control Plan and to grant county inspectors, MDE and/or MD DNR the right of entry to the site to monitor compliance. Each of the undersigned is aware of the property owner's responsibility in preventing erosion and sedimentation during and after forest harvest operations as mandated by the rules and regulations adopted by the State of Maryland and the local ordinances, rules and regulations of Harford County, Maryland. The undersigned agrees to require that all operators conducting forest harvest operations on the above-named property shall adhere to the requirements of the standard plan and any amendments to the plan.

Removal of stumps in harvest operations is not permitted except as necessary for landing areas or haul roads under the terms of this permit. This permit expires one year from the date signed by the Harford County Soil Conservation District.
