- Keeps a roster of all registered team members.
- Submits the team roster by 3:00 p.m on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 to [rideshare@harfordcountymd.gov](mailto:rideshare@harfordcountymd.gov). The roster will be compared to online B2WD registrations for accuracy.

### Bike to work!

- Team leader (or designated representative) must be present at the Pit Stop, located at the Harford County Administration Building Parking Lot, 220 S. Main Street, between 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Be sure to note your team leader status upon check in.
- Team members are not required to check in at the Pit Stop and can bike all or part of their commute.
- Only those registered with Bel Air will qualify.
