How to Attach Inspection Pictures on the ePermit Center

1. Log into your account

a. ePermit Center website:

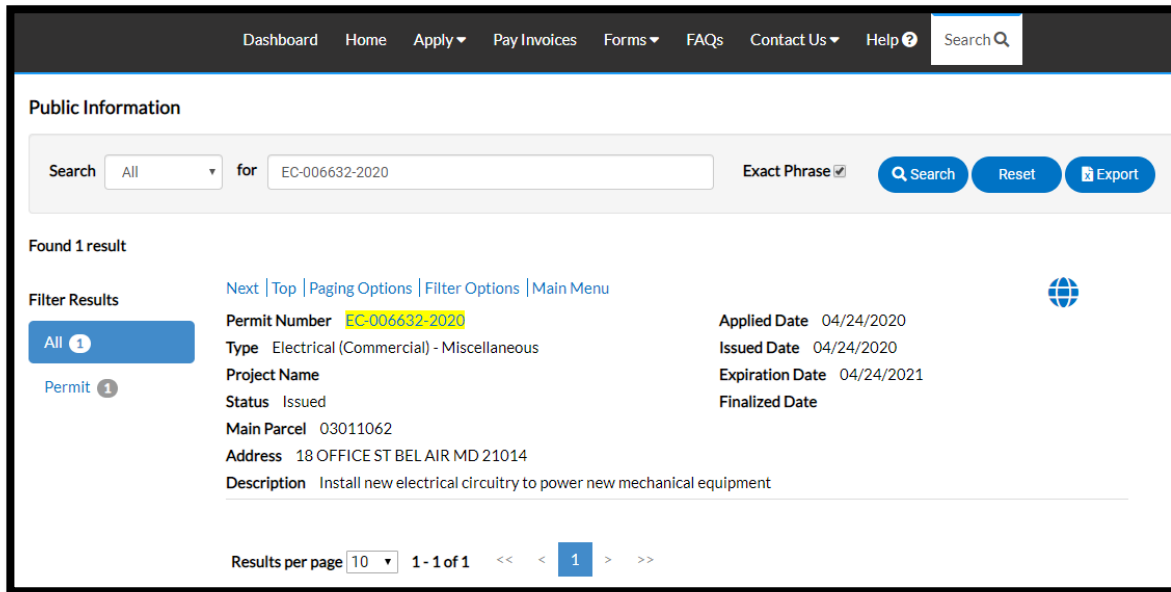
