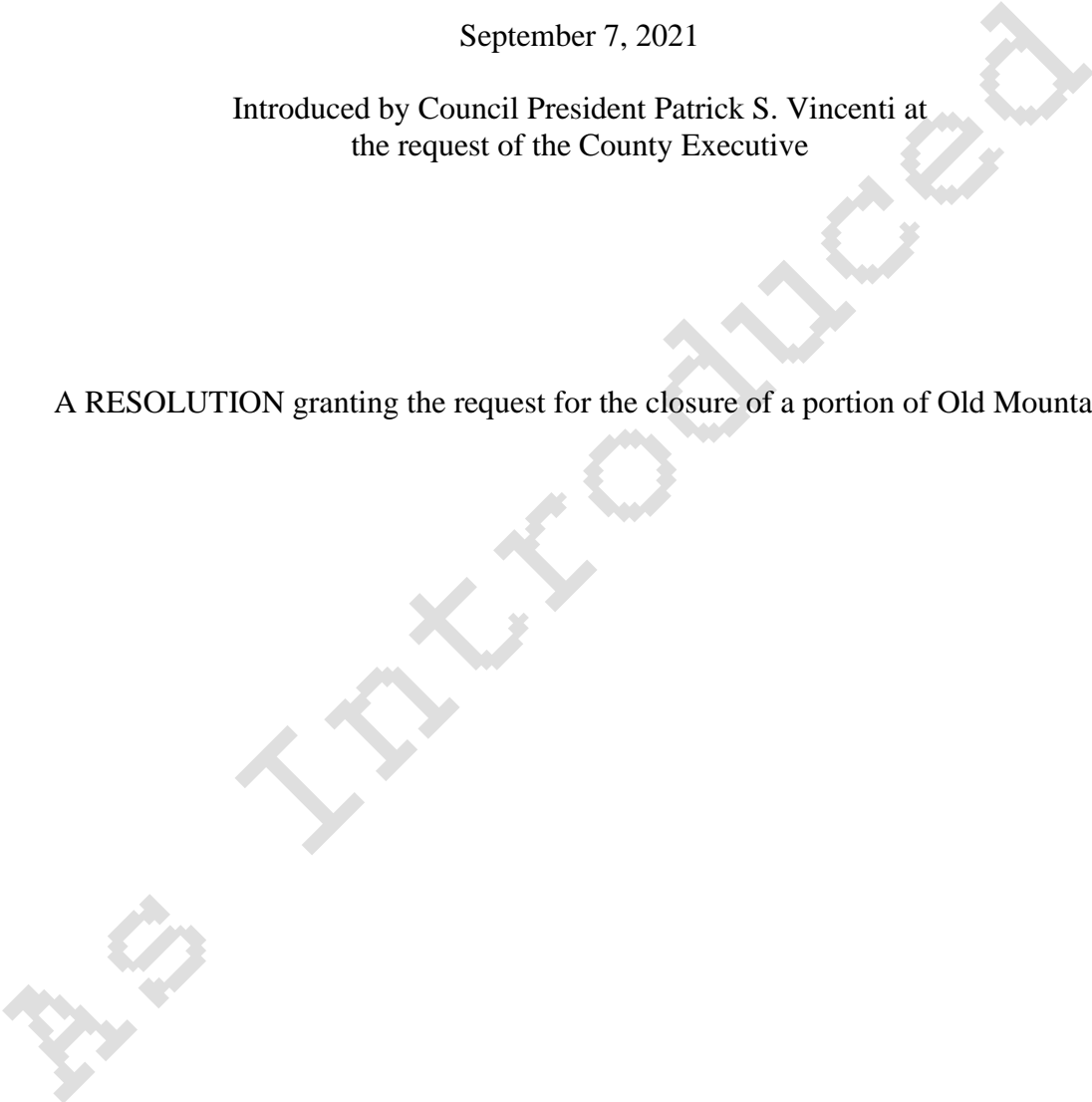

A RESOLUTION granting the request for the closure of a portion of Old Mountain Road.



RESOLUTION NO. 039-21

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has requested the closure of the portion of
2 Old Mountain Road which passes over Interstate I-95 starting at the approximate limit of the
3 current Maryland Transportation Authority (“MdTA”) right of way, on the north side of Interstate
4 I-95, which is approximately 805 feet south of Maryland Route 152 and terminating at the
5 approximate limit of the current MdTA right of way, on the south side of Interstate I-95,
6 approximately 1,400 feet north of Maryland Route 7; and

7 WHEREAS, after advertising the hearing date, a public hearing was held on February 11,
8 2021, by the Road Closing Committee (the “Committee”) to consider whether Old Mountain Road
9 should be closed; and

10 WHEREAS, the Committee, after considering all the testimony and information related to
11 this requested closure, voted in favor of closing Old Mountain Road, contingent upon the
12 following conditions being met prior to the closing of the road:

13 1. The Maryland Transportation Authority shall complete construction of a cul-de-sac,
14 including acquisition of any required rights of way, at each terminus of Old
15 Mountain Road on both the north and south sides of Interstate I-95 in conjunction
16 with the removal of the existing Old Mountain Road Bridge over Interstate I-95 as
17 indicated in the construction plans for the northbound I-95 Express Toll Lane
18 (ETL) project.

19 2. The Maryland Transportation Authority shall maintain access for all properties on
20 Old Mountain Road throughout construction.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Harford County,
22 Maryland, that the Council finds the requested closing satisfies the procedures established by law,

- 1 rules and regulations for the closing of county roads and hereby grants the Committee’s request to
- 2 close a portion of Old Mountain Road contingent upon the above-listed conditions.
