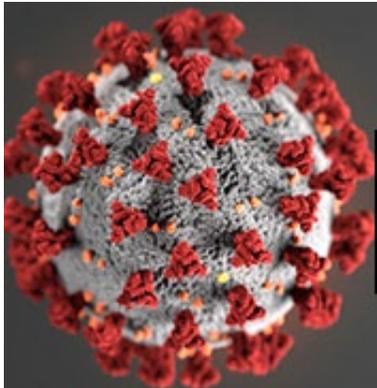
One resolution I try to keep every year is from our [Choose Civility Harford County](#) program in partnership with Harford County Public Library.

COVID update

We're seeing a rise in [COVID-19 cases](#) with the omicron variant and with activities moving indoors. I continue to monitor daily metrics, especially hospitalizations, as our focus is on preventing serious illness. The University of Maryland Upper Chesapeake Health reports that 75% of their COVID-19 patients are unvaccinated, as are 100% of COVID patients currently on ventilators.

I continue to encourage everyone who is eligible to [get vaccinated](#) and get the booster as one of the best ways to avoid a trip to the hospital.

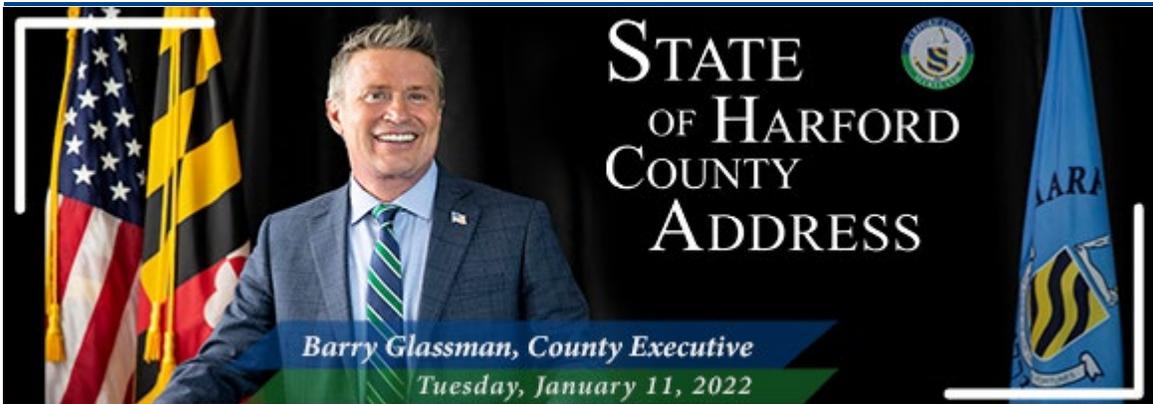

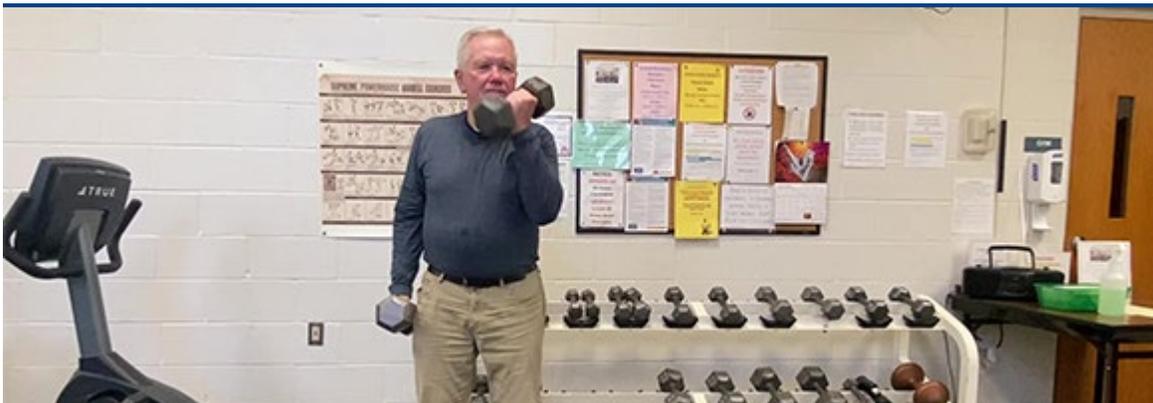
Free recycling for your Christmas tree & lights

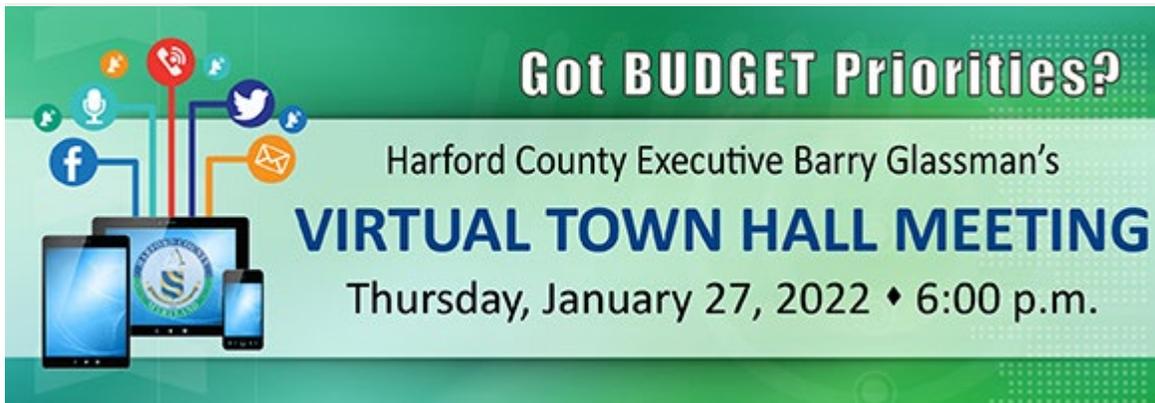
State of the County address January 11

Household hazardous waste collection February 1

Harford County residents can drop off household hazardous waste for free on Tuesday, Feb. 1 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Harford Mulch & Compost Facility. Household hazardous waste is any leftover material that is corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive. Examples include oil-based paints, solvents, pesticides, herbicides, drain cleaners, and pool chemicals. Visit the county website for a [complete list of acceptable items](#). Please note, this event is for residents only, no commercial businesses are allowed. The facility is located at 3139 Scarboro Road in Street.



Winter weather safety

The cold weather is a good reminder to review our winter safety tips. When using kerosene heaters, be sure to maintain proper ventilation to avoid a build-up of toxic fumes. In case of a power outage, never run a generator inside your home. And please take care of yourself by avoiding over exertion outdoors and remember to check on the elderly and other vulnerable neighbors. Just in case ... Harford County's Snow Plow Tracker

During major snowstorms, you can track the location of county snowplows with our Harford County Snow Plow Tracker app. Activated when snow reaches six inches or more, the tracker shows the location of our GPS-equipped plows on county roads using an online map updated every 15 minutes.
