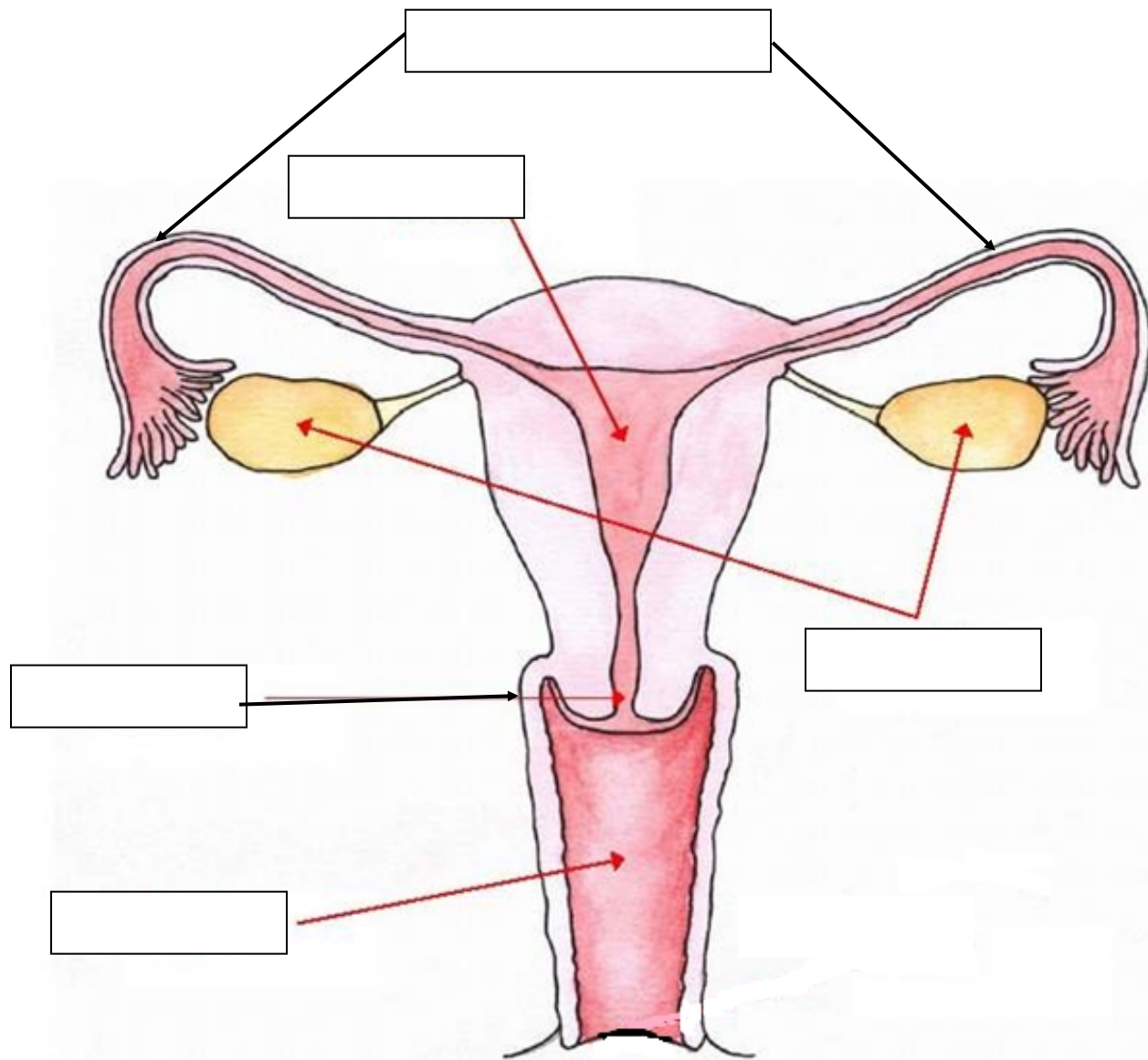


FEMALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

	The female reproductive cell. It is also called the egg cell.
	Stores the ova (egg) and hormones that cause the egg to mature.
	Carry the egg from the ovaries to the uterus.
	Shelters and nourishes the growing baby.
	Opening of the uterus.
	Muscular passageway from the uterus to the outside of the body.
	A reoccurring cycle where the lining of the uterus prepares for pregnancy.
	Flow of the lining material out of the female.
	When the ovaries release one mature egg cell each month.
