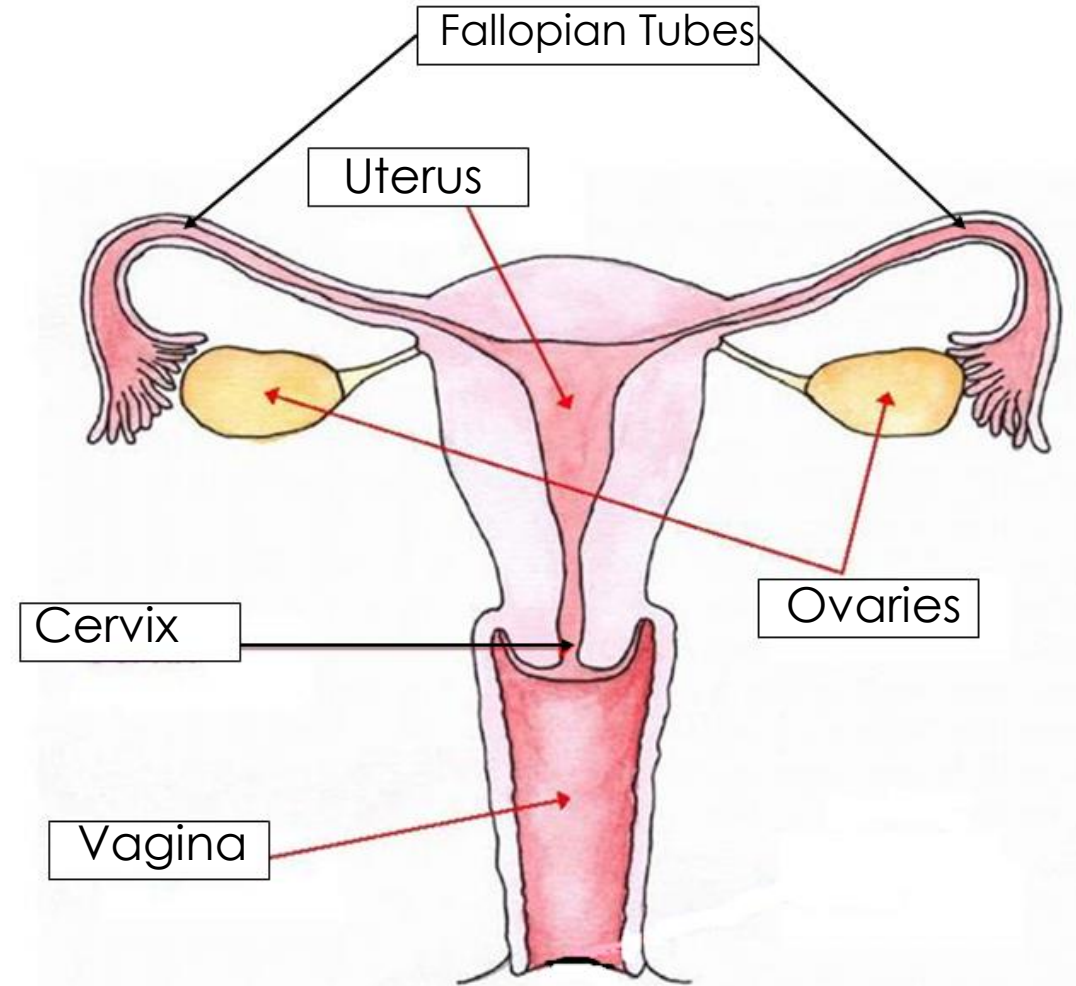

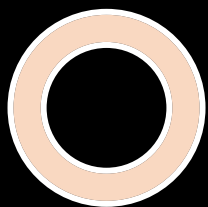

Female Reproductive System

Ova:

The female reproductive cell. It is also called the egg cell.

Ovaries:

Stores the ova (egg) and hormones that cause the egg to mature.

Fallopian Tubes:

Carries the egg from the ovaries to the uterus.



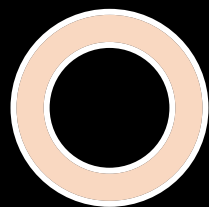
Uterus:

Shelters and nourishes the growing baby.

Cervix:

Opening of the uterus.





Female Reproductive System

Vagina:

Muscular passageway from the uterus to the outside of the body.

Menstrual Cycle:

a recurring cycle where the lining of the uterus prepares for pregnancy.

Menstruation:

● Flow of the lining material out of the female.
