





- Vagina





Female Reproductive System Vocabulary

Ova

The female reproductive cell (egg cell)

Ovaries

Stores the ova (egg) and hormones that cause the egg to mature

Fallopian Tube

Carry the egg from the ovaries to the uterus

Shelters and
nourishes the
growing baby

Cervix


Opening of the

Vagina

Muscular
passageway from
the uterus to the
outside of the body

Menstrual Cycle


A reoccurring cycle

the uterus prepares
for pregnancy

Menstruation


Flow of the lining

When the ovaries
release one mature
egg cell each
month






The male

Vas Deferens


Urethra

Penis


Tubes that extend

Male Reproductive System Vocabulary



Semen

A mixture of sperm and fluid

Erection

When the penis fills with blood and becomes larger and harder

Ejaculation

Forces the semen through the urethra and out of the body

Nocturnal Emissions

When a boy releases semen in his sleep
