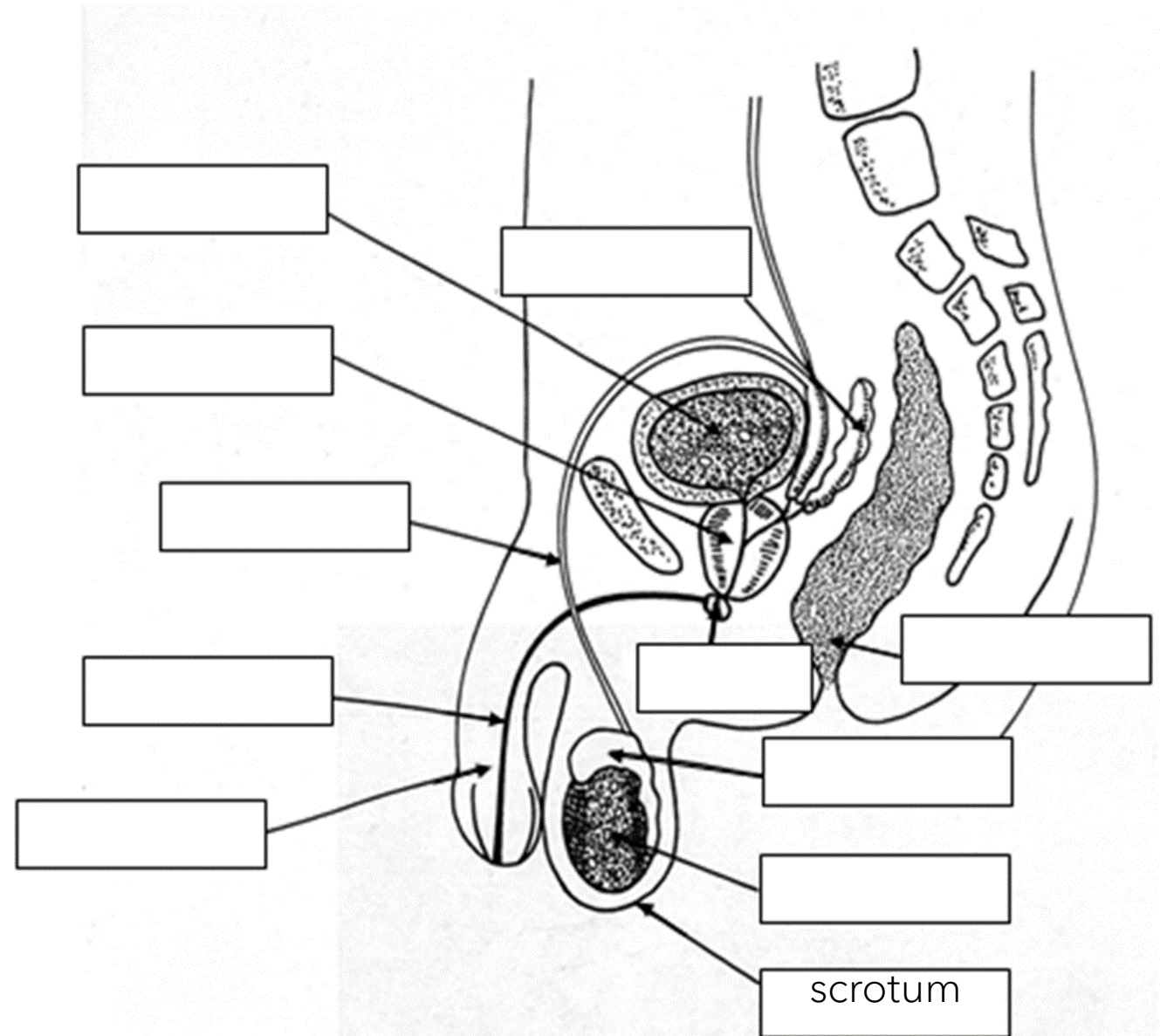

12. Ejaculation

Forces the semen through the urethra and out of the body

13. Pre- ejaculation

Fluid that is released before an ejaculation which contains sperm

14. Foreskin

Loose skin covering the end of the penis
