Female Hormones




Estrogen:

a female sex that produces female secondary sex characteristics & affects the menstrual cycle

Progesterone:

A female sex hormone that prepares the uterus for the fertilized ovum and maintains pregnancy

Uterus



Female Reproductive Terms

- 1. Ovaries** - Stores the ova (egg cell) & hormones that cause the eggs to mature
- 2. Fallopian Tubes**- Carry the egg from the ovaries to the uterus
- 3. Uterus**- Shelters & Nourishes the fetus
- 4. Vagina**- Muscular passageway from the uterus to the outside of the body
- 5. Urethra**- the narrow tube that carries urine from the body

Female Reproductive Terms

6. Cervix- opening of the uterus

7. Menstruation- Flow of the uterine lining out of the female

8. Ovulation- When the ovaries release one mature egg cell each month


9. Ova- the female reproductive cell

10. Menstrual Cycle- the reoccurring cycle that includes:

- Menstruation
- Ovulation
- Repair/building of the uterine wall

Menstrual Cycle

A woman's reproductive system works on a 28-day cycle


