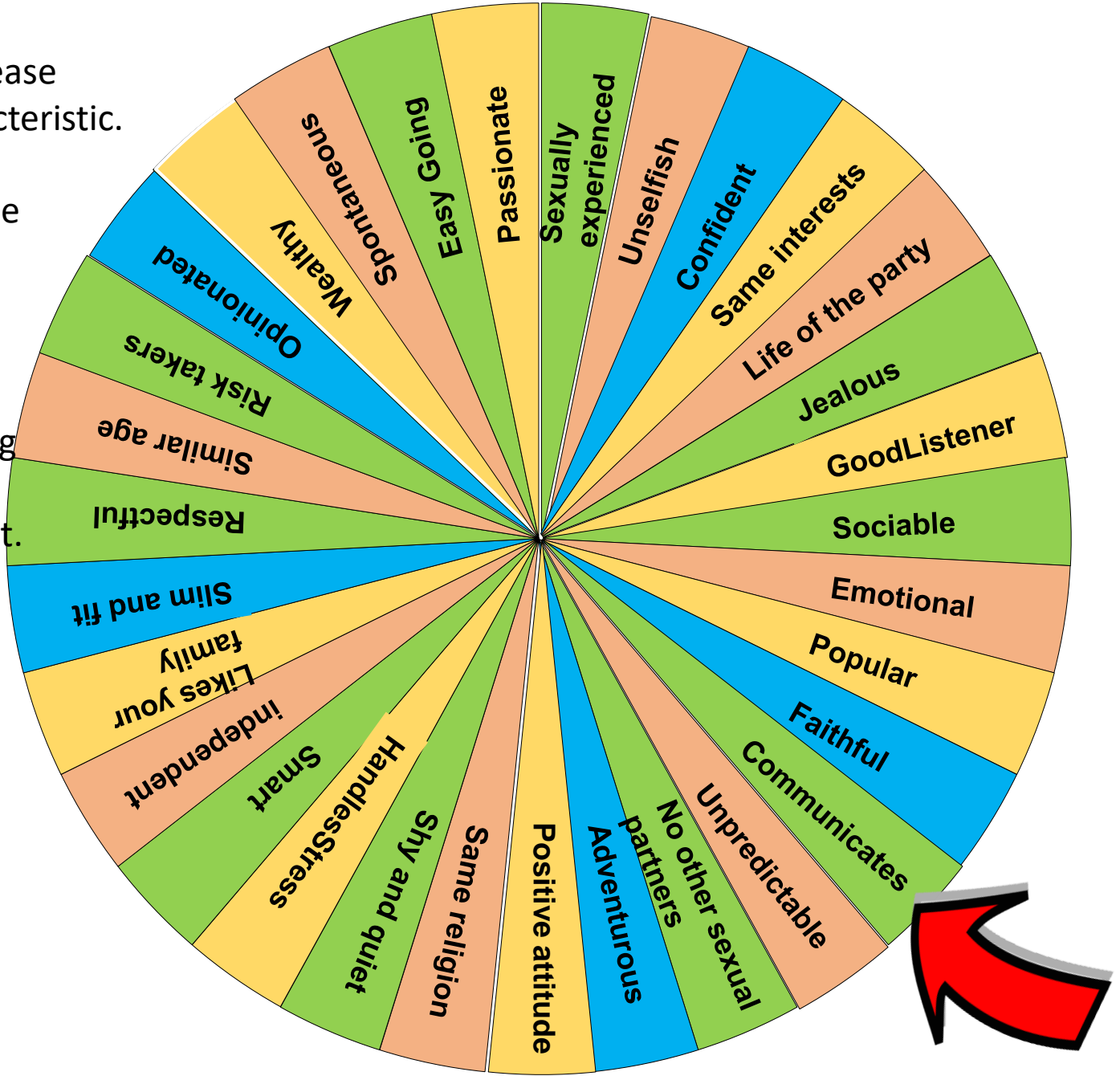


# Exploring Relationships



Directions: To complete the CHART on the next slide, please “spin the wheel” to randomly select a relationship characteristic.

- 1.To spin the wheel, click ONCE on the wheel to START the spinning, THEN click again to stop the spinning.
- 2.The RED ARROW will indicate the selected relationship characteristic.
- 3. Use that characteristic as YOUR first characteristic to complete the chart on the corresponding worksheet.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 SIX more times to complete the chart.

Directions: Spin the Wheel 7 times to identify 7 different relationship characteristics. You are to personally reflect on each selected characteristic. Then place each characteristic as you feel fit (crucial, important, or not necessary). Each time you spin the wheel, place the named characteristic in any of the 3 provided columns in the chart.
