

Scenarios - What Should They Do?

Directions: Read the scenario. With your group, discuss what you believe the people in the scenario should do next. Record your group's response on the handout. Be prepared to share your group's response during a class discussion.

Scenario 1:

A student at school has been asking around about one of your friends. Your friend thinks the person is kind of cute and may be interested in them, but they aren't quite sure yet. Somehow the student got your friend's number and texts them, "Hey." Your friend isn't expecting the text, but responds back, "Who's this?" The answer your friend receives is "It's me," followed by a naked picture of the student.

What should your friend do?

Scenario 2:

Two eleventh graders are in a relationship, and they are really into each other. Within their relationships, they send flirty texts back and forth talking about how attracted they are to each other. One day, one partner texts "Send me something I can look at and think of you." The other partner doesn't see anything wrong with it since their relationship is going so well. They send a response back with a naked picture of themselves and a text "Just 4 you." The next day, three different people come up to the person telling them how hot they thought their picture was.

What should they do?
