3. What should this couple do?: A couple is having vaginal sex, and the condom breaks. They don't have any more condoms with them.
4. A person notices small red bumps on the outside of their genitals. They don't look like the slides they saw in science class at school so maybe it's a heat rash. They've had sex before and used condoms a few times. What are THREE THINGS should they do?
5. A couple is talking about having sex soon. Both have had sex before with other partners. What should they do prior to having sex?
