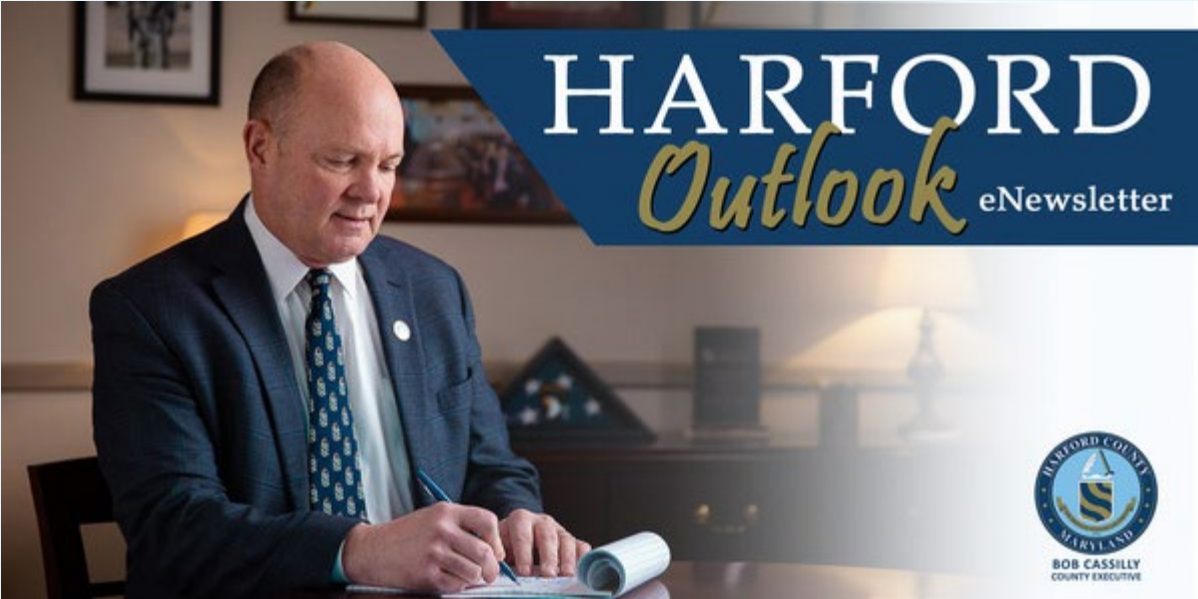

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

Drop off items for free on August 8

Harford County residents can drop off household hazardous waste for free from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Tuesday, August 8 at the Harford Mulch & Compost Facility in Street. Household hazardous waste is any leftover material that is corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive. Examples include oil-based paints, solvents, pesticides, herbicides, drain cleaners, and pool chemicals. Visit the county website for a [complete list of acceptable items](#). Please note, this event is for residents only, no commercial businesses are allowed. The facility is located at 3139 Scarboro Road.
