- 1. How are you working to bridge the gap of service between Harford and Baltimore County? Can we have a connection to White Marsh?**

Currently Harford Transit LINK provides service to the MARC train locations in Aberdeen and Edgewood. These stations provide service to Baltimore County, Baltimore City and Washington D.C. Our buses do not connect with any locations in White Marsh. The closest location our buses travel to Baltimore County would be Redner's in Joppatowne. There are no transit bus connections between Harford and Baltimore counties.

- 2. What is the possibility of connecting to Baltimore City, possibly connecting with the Light Rail for employment, medical needs, and social events.**
