The Grant In Aid Program fosters sustainable communities by coordinating with municipalities, public and private agencies, civic organizations and community members to address needs in our community. Grant In Aid administers grants to public service organizations serving at risk populations, low-income households, individuals with differing abilities, disadvantaged youth, senior citizens and the recovery community.

Our goal is to enhance human services in Harford County and provide support to our public/private partners that are striving to meet the emergent and daily needs of Harford County citizens. To carry out its mission, Grant In Aid awards operating and project reimbursement grants to qualified applicants. The Grant In Aid process is reviewed by Community Development Review Board members.

Funds were allocated to the following organizations and projects*:

755 Alliance	\$5,000	Funds emergency items such as rent, car repairs, utility turn off notices, etc. for Edgewood area residents.
Associated Catholic Charities, Inc. (Anna's House)	\$70,000	Operating costs for Anna's House providing transitional and permanent housing for women and children experiencing homelessness.
Associated Catholic Charities, Inc. (Early Head Start)	\$35,000	Funds the Home Visitor program.
