

HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ETHICS – COMPLAINT 25-07

On July 28, 2025, the Harford County Board of Ethics received a Complaint alleging violations of Chapter 23 of the Harford County Code (“the Ethics Code”). The Complaint is known as Complaint 25-07.

The Harford County Board of Ethics, having reviewed Ethics Complaint No. 25-07, finds, pursuant to Section 23-4B. of the Ethics Code, that there is no reasonable basis to believe a violation occurred. The Board concludes that the subject of Complaint 25-07 had no role in, nor responsibility for, the publication of the Ethics Board’s opinion issued in Complaint 25-01. Based on the allegations in Complaint 25-07, the Board finds that the subject did not violate the Ethics Code because the subject did not take any direct action in, and was not directly responsible for, publishing Complaint 25-01 on the County’s website. As there is no factual foundation to support the allegations, the Board hereby summarily dismisses the complaint in its entirety.
