Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund (CRRF)

The Harford County Department of Housing and Community Services (DHCS) announces the Fiscal Year 2027 round of Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund (CRRF) grant applications. CRRF provides funding to local jurisdictions to support community-based initiatives that benefit low-income communities and communities that have been disproportionately impacted by the enforcement of cannabis prohibition.

The Harford County Department of Housing and Community Services (DHCS) will solicit applications for the following programs:

- Housing and Homelessness Services
- Community-Based Initiatives
- Behavioral Health
- Children and Youth (separate timeline)

The full funding notice will be available online at <https://www.harfordcountymd.gov/3325/Grants-Portal> beginning Friday, December 19, 2025. Applications will be available beginning Monday, January 5, 2026, except for Children and Youth. The deadline for application submission is Friday, February 13, 2026 at 4:00 p.m, except for Children and Youth.

Children and Youth applications will be available Monday, February 17, 2026. The deadline for Children and Youth application submission is Friday, March 13, 2026 at 4:00pm.

***NEW for FY2027:** Technical assistance will be available during scheduled office hours only. Applicants must schedule an appointment for technical assistance by emailing odcp@harfordcountymd.gov during times available in the full funding notice under "Submission and Timeline". The deadline to schedule office hours for the above grant programs, except for Children and Youth, is January 23, 2026 at 4:00PM. The deadline to schedule office hours for Children and Youth is February 23, 2026 at 4:00PM.

A virtual applicant workshop will be held on Wednesday, January 14, 2026 at 9:30am. Please email your name, agency, and telephone number to odcp@harfordcountymd.gov to receive the meeting invitation.

Private, nonprofit organizations with IRS 501(c)(3) status, and in some cases, for-profit entities may be eligible to receive funding under these programs. All proposed programs/projects must meet applicable state regulations. All selected programs/projects are subject to the availability of funding and Harford County's budget review process. Harford County maintains the right to reject or accept proposals to fund or not to fund, or to reduce the amount of funding requested.
