## STOP THROWING YOUR MONEY AWAY

### *Trash is expensive*

Trash is expensive to handle and landfill. Landfilling takes up valuable county land and tax dollars.

### *Recycling is not*

Reduce your trash and you should see a reduction in your waste removal costs by reducing pickups and/or the number of trash containers required.

### *Did you know?*

83% of the trash generated in the United States is recyclable (EPA, 2011 Facts and Figures).

The Single Stream program allows you to recycle cans, glass bottles, plastic and paper all together in one container.



### *Follow these steps to get started on your recycling plan*

- 1) Evaluate your current system
- 2) Determine the number and type of recycling containers needed (remember to plan for residents moving in and out)
- 3) Contact a trash hauler to negotiate a contract or make plans to self haul recyclables (be sure to compare rates between companies)
- 4) Create a written plan following Section XI of the Harford County Recycling Plan
- 5) Educate your residents as outlined in your plan
- 6) Assess and adjust your plan as necessary

In Fiscal Year 2016, Harford county is charging \$72 per ton to handle trash while recycling is accepted for FREE. More recycling in your development may allow you to reduce dumpster size and/or the frequency of pick up, leading to a reduction in your bills.
