Server's Identification Training

Due to the increased demand for Server's Identification Training (formerly Prevention Techniques Training), the Liquor Board inspectors will now be presenting the training twice each month at the office of the Liquor Control Board, 16 North Main Street, Bel Air. The training is available free to all licensees and their employees and covers identifying those under the age of twenty-one, preventing the sale of alcohol to intoxicated subjects, false identity documents, and server's rights and responsibilities.
